COL Haileyesus (Hailey) Bairu was born in Addis Ababa, Ethiopia and grew up in Cincinnati, Ohio after immigrating to the United States in 1980. Upon graduating high school, COL Bairu attended the United States Military Academy where he earned a bachelor's of science degree in Systems Engineering and was commissioned as an Air Defense Officer in 2003.

COL Bairu's operational experience after graduating Officer Basic Course in 2004 includes, serving as Platoon Leader and Battery Executive Officer for Alpha Battery, 2nd Battalion, 44th

Air Defense Artillery Regiment, Fort Campbell, KY and deploying with the Battalion to Operation Iraqi Freedom III in 2005.
