



MOVING TO 10TH AAMDC IN A COVID-19 ENVIRONMENT

We're glad you're coming to 10th AAMDC and wanted you to be aware of what to expect under the conditions-based, phased approach to PCSing within a COVID-19 environment.

The key is to remain FLEXIBLE.



Meet one of three travel authorization categories:

Exempt Status: All initial entry Soldiers and Officers moving to their first duty station, movement to/from professional military education, military training, low/no cost moves.

Unrestricted Movement: If the origin, destination, and all intermediate stops are designated as unrestricted locations, the traveler may continue movement without the requirement of a waiver.
(Final verification w/ S1 10 days prior to travel)

Waivered: A request for a waiver for extreme hardship, humanitarian reasons or mission essential personnel can be submitted in order to move from, to, or through a restricted area.
Talk to your S1 to obtain the appropriate request templates.

Restricted Movement - If the origin, destination, or intermediate stop is designated restricted, travel may not proceed without an approved waiver from a designated GO. In many situations, also approved by the first General officer in the chain-of-command at the gaining unit.


